- All dancing shall be conducted under the Rules of the Piping & Dancing Assn. of N.Z
- In the event of a tie for Most Points, rule 13 will apply, aggregate marks may be used
- Registration cards must be produced when picking up numbers no registration card means you will be required to register on the day.
- ALL Events will be run together where possible
- The committee reserves the right to run some events 3 competitors dancing at a time
- <u>No reports will be given</u> apart from Championship events, Mrs Hardy Memorial, Merit Awards and the Novice Fling
- Championships, Merit Award, Mrs Hardy Memorial, Restricted, Novice & Local Flings events do not count for Most Points
- Championships must have 5 or more competitors or will become an ordinary event
- Insufficient entries for Reel dances in brackets will apply
- Trophies will be given out as stipulated in the listed schedule of trophies not as it is engraved on the trophies
- Local Dancers only, which are "Those residing in the Gore local toll-free area or locally taught", are eligible for Local Most Points
- Competitors enter at their own risk and the Gore Society shall not be responsible for any loss of property or accidents
- Junior dancers (Under 14 years) may dance in their own age group and one above only with the exception of Restricted events, Mrs Hardy Memorial, Merit Awards and Championships.
- Dancers must assemble and be ready to dance when called upon or the right to compete in the event maybe withdrawn.
- "By entering this competition or event, I agree to hereby grant the Piping and Dancing Association of New Zealand ("Association") the right to use my name, image, photograph, picture or video captured performance in connection with the Association.
