Rules and Conditions

- 1) All events conducted under the NZ Piping & Dancing Association rules, except class 1
- 2) All entries must be accompanied by correct payment
- 3) Dancers compete at their own risk
- 4) Current NZ P&D registration cards must be shown when uplifting number
- 5) Prizes as follows: medals will be presented in all classes (except classes 4, 9, 12, 18) for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. VHC, HC and C certificates will be awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator. Classes 4, 9, 12, 18 will be awarded rosettes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. VHC, HC and C certificates will be awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator. In the case of more than 15 competitors in any class a 4th place will be awarded
- 6) Competitors must be in attendance to draw for reels or forfeit their right to compete in this event
- 7) In Reel classes where there are insufficient entries a solo dance will be substituted
- 8) Double sword entry (class 27) is payable by both competitors, partners name must be stated on entry form
