In the event of a tie, Piping & Dancing Association Rule 13 will apply.

*Competitors in Open aggregate can choose points gained in either event 1 or 2 but not both.

Aggregate Trophies and Special Prizes awarded on the basis of 5 for 1st, 3 for 2nd and 1 for 3rd

13a. Piping Competitions. Where a prize is awarded for most points over a number of events points shall be computed on the basis of five for each first placing, three for each second and one for each third. In the event of a tie for any placing the above points shall be shared in the same manner as applies to prize money. If the total points of two or more competitors shall be equal, the competitor who has gained the highest placing in the Piobaireachd event (if conducted) shall be awarded the most points prize. If a Piobaireachd event is not conducted for a particular grade, and the total points of 2 or more competitors shall be equal, then Rule 13 applies. The conditions under which other special prizes are awarded shall be clearly stated in the schedule.
