Beginners Class

- Event 1 – Introduction and Bow, 32 counts of 2nd Point and Flinging, no turn, Bow, arms Akimbo
- Event 2 – Bow, 4 count Introduction, Six Pas de Basque side to side at Sword Hilt followed by four
- Closed Spring points, 16 time counts, Bow, arms Akimbo.
- Dress optional for all events. Kilt or studio uniform recommended.

Other Notes for the day

- The stage will be under a large marquee and some chairs will be available.
- Bring your own small gazebo, fold out chairs and table to enjoy the outside day
- Food is available around The Square in close proximity cafes and supermarkets
- 9.30am sharp start, and we expect to finish around 2pm
- Free parking is available around The Square until 11am, after 11am on street parking is \$2 per hour.
