# GENERAL CONTROLS THAT APPLY AT ALL LEVELS FOR COMPETITIONS

# My Vaccine Pass must be sighted for all

(NB: as per covid19.govt.nz - Children under the age of 12 years and 3 months are not required to show proof of vaccination status under the traffic light system).

attendees 12 year and over.

- Medical Exemption: (as per covid19.govt.nz) If you are unable to get the COVID-19 vaccine for medical reasons, there is an exemption process to get your My Vaccine Pass. You will need to talk to your doctor and they will apply on your behalf.
- Contact Tracing system must be put in place by the organisation conducting the competition. (QR Code or manual sign in system for those who can't scan in.)
- Any person who is unwell should not attend the competition.

## Hygiene:

- Hand Sanitiser is to be available throughout the venue. (If outdoors competition, ensure Hand Sanitiser is available at the Secretary's Table and beside Dance / Piping / Drumming Platforms.)
- Ensure washroom facilities have liquid soap and disposable paper towels.
- Suitable rubbish receptacles must be provided.
- **Ventilation:** (at indoor venues)
  - All doors or windows that can be opened should be opened to ensure good ventilation where no air conditioning system available.

# ADDITIONAL CONTROLS SPECIFIC TO **EACH LEVEL**

LEVEL

Maximum number of attendees will be 100 (this does not include workers)

(NB. Workers include anyone required to operate the business or service, and therefore includes paid and unpaid.)

- 1 metre physical distancing to be applied.
  - Ensure changing rooms have a maximum of one person per square metre.
- Face coverings are encouraged but not mandatory.
- Organisers will either pre draw events or have the board steward draw for all competitors.
- Swords to be placed and handled only by the board stewards on the day.
- Reel Dances dancers must sanitise before and after performing.
- Kitchen:
  - No food sales will be conducted.
  - Food preparation for Judges and officials must be conducted with increased hygiene measures in place - gloves to be worn and tongs used etc.
  - Face Coverings are encouraged but not Mandatory.
