## **PACANZ National Young Performer Award 2022 Criteria for Highland and National Dancing**

The Young performer awards in 2021 were unable to be held due to COVID. Nominations for the 2022 Awards remain open for Highland Category with the 2021 Age Criteria requirements as follows:

- Competitors will be **14 and under 25 years** as at **1<sup>st</sup> October, 2021**
- Each competitor shall perform three dances.

1. Choice of one solo Highland dance: Highland Fling, Seann Truibhas, Sword Dance
2. Choice of one solo Irish Step dance: Irish Jig Single Time, Irish Jig Double Time, Irish Hornpipe
3. Sailors Hornpipe

### **SOCIETY NOMINATION:**

Each Society, which is a financial member of PACANZ, may nominate up to two competitors, who will be selected by the adjudicators. Our Society offers one nomination.

The adjudicators will determine that a competitor has displayed a sufficient standard of performance to competently represent that society at the National Finals, to be held in **Palmerston North, October 2022.**

The standard required will be at the absolute discretion of the adjudicators but will include:

- A demonstration of adequate preparation
- An authority of performance
- A performance with a level of maturity commensurate with a national final competition of this age group

If the adjudicators consider that a sufficient standard has NOT been reached by any competitor, then NO nomination will be made.

The Nominee is responsible for paying their portion of the entry fee to the National Young Performer Award - **\$175.00 (inc. GST)**

### **DIRECT ENTRY NOMINATION:**

If the adjudicators consider that more than 1 performer has reached a sufficient standard, those competitors will be given the option of a **Direct Entry Nomination**. This performer is required to pay the full entry fee of **\$250.00 (inc GST)**

**Competitors should be aware that they should only enter & accept a nomination if they are intending to participate in the Finals of the National Young Performer Awards.**
