- In the event of a tie, Rule 13 will apply and aggregate marks will not be used.
- If there are fewer than five competitors for a championship, the committee may hold the event as an ordinary dance and reduce the prize money accordingly.
- The committee reserves the right to change the order of events as they see fit.
- Competitors compete at own risk and the committee accepts no responsibility for accidents, mishaps, theft or misplacement of personal property. Only on these conditions is entry accepted.

This competition will be held indoors in a rural community hall. There are no shops nearby. Please bring all food and drink and equipment with you. We will have hot water available so you can make hot drinks.

**COVID-19 Risk Management Plan and guidelines**

The most up to date information regarding the competitions will be emailed out prior to the competition. The competition will proceed with specific guidelines in place listed below to minimise and mitigate risk of exposure or transmission of COVID-19:

- Do not attend if you feel unwell or have been in contact with anyone who is unwell.
- My Vaccine Pass must be sighted for all attendees 12 year and over. (NB: as per covid19.govt.nz - Children under the age of 12 years and 3 months are not required to show proof of vaccination status under the traffic light system).
- All attendees must scan contact tracing on entry.
- Hand sanitiser will be available.
- Face masks are encouraged. Dancers may wear a mask during their performance if they wish.
- Minimum 1m distancing but try to maintain 2m distancing where possible and avoid interaction with people you do not know.
- Competitors will compete in the order prescribed by the officials of the society. For this competition that is: for solo dances, competitors will dance in the descending order of their competitor numbers provided on the day. All Reels and Championships will be drawn by the steward.
- The hall will be set up with seating in family bubbles and further studio bubbles. Please stay within these limits where possible to minimise interaction.
- Competitors will sit at 1m distance by the stage while awaiting their turn to compete and can stand to warm up/stretch 1 dance in advance of their performance.
- There will be no kitchen on the day and no food preparation will be allowed within the kitchen area with the exception of the committee preparing the adjudicator and stewards lunch. Hot water will be available for teas and coffees, but no kitchen crockery will be available for use by attendees. Please bring your own.
- If you feel unwell after attending the competition, please get a COVID test and follow Ministry of Health instructions for further advice on what you should do and how to proceed.

**RED LIGHT:**

- To ensure we keep under 100 people will be permitted no non-competitive siblings of competitors can attend, and only one supporting adult per competitor allowed.
- Swords will be placed and handled only by the stewards of the day. In the event of the sword needing adjusting after a previous dancer misplaced, then this is to be handled only by the steward.
- Reel dances will go ahead but dancers must sanitise before and after performing.

**ORANGE LIGHT:**

- There will be no restriction on numbers.
