AGE: as at the commencement of competitions. Birth certificate must be produced if asked for.

LOCAL: All Waimate District — between Waitaki & Pareora Rivers.

REGISTRATION: Current registration cards must be shown when uplifting competitor number.

DRAW: Each competitor must make their own draw, reporting to the Draw Steward when called.

ENTRIES: Will not be accepted unless accompanied by all fees.

Competitors must report to the Stage Manager immediately their class is called or forfeit the right to compete. The programme order will be strictly adhered to.

All competitors compete at their own risk. The Waimate Competitions Society accepts **no responsibility** for accidents, mishaps, theft or misplacement of personal property.

Any person found damaging Regent Theatre property will be liable for full restitution; and if a competitor, may forfeit the right to compete.
