

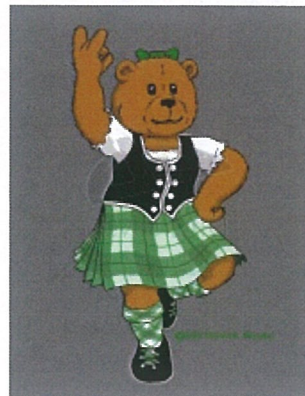

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • My Vaccine Pass must be sighted for all attendees 12 years 3 months and over. (NB: As per covid19.govt.nz - Children under the age of 12 years and 3 months are not required to show proof of vaccination status under the traffic light system). The Host committee may offer the ability for competitors to email their covid pass, with the following special conditions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. That it is sighted/verified in the normal way (i.e. using the verify app), checking DOB and name. 2. Only the expiry date is recorded in the competitors records 3. The email is deleted. • The last step is important as covid passes must not be stored in any way (including in email archives). • The PDANZ encourages attendees 5 – 11 years to be vaccinated. • Medical Exemption: (as per covid19.govt.nz) If you are unable to get the COVID-19 vaccine for medical reasons, there is an exemption process to get your My Vaccine Pass. You will need to talk to your doctor and they will apply on your behalf. • Contact Tracing system must be put in place by the organisation conducting the competition. (QR Code or manual sign in system for those who can't scan in.) • Any person who is unwell should not attend the competition. • Hygiene: • Competition organisers should have a box of disposable masks available as required. • Hand Sanitiser is to be available throughout the venue. (If outdoors competition, ensure Hand Sanitiser is available at the Secretary's Table and beside Dance / Piping / Drumming Platforms.) • Ensure washroom facilities have liquid soap and disposable paper towels. • Suitable rubbish receptacles must be provided. • Ventilation: (at indoor venues) • All doors or windows that can be opened should be opened to ensure good ventilation where no air conditioning system available. 	<p>Maximum number of attendees will be 100 (this does not include workers) (NB. Workers include anyone required to operate the business or service, and therefore includes paid and unpaid.)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Masks must be worn by all attendees aged 8 yrs (or Year 4) and over unless a valid mask exemption is supplied. (Masks only to be removed by competitors prior to performance on stage. Dancers may wear masks while competing.) • Organisers will either pre draw events or have the board steward draw for all competitors. • Swords to be placed and handled only by the board stewards on the day. • 1m Physical Distancing Requirements to be applied in venue. This includes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ensuring a minimum of 1 metre distance between each family group in changing rooms. - 1 metre spacing should be maintained between competitors lined up waiting to compete and between prize winners during presentations. - No reel dances should be held at the Red Traffic Light setting. • Reports for Dancing Competitions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - With the exception of Island Championships, no judges' reports at the Red Traffic Light setting. - For Island Championships, a writer can not be used and the organisation conducting the championship may need to allow extra time for the judge to complete a brief report for each competitor. • Kitchen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No food sales should be conducted. - Food preparation for Judges and officials must be conducted with increased hygiene measures in place – gloves to be worn and tongs used etc. 	<div style="text-align: center;">  </div>
