- \* A 4<sup>th</sup> medal will be given for 12 or more entries in any one class and a 5<sup>th</sup> medal will be given if 15 or more entries in any one class.
- \* There will be the ability to set up gazebos and outdoor seating on a grassed area near the hall and there will be limited seating inside the hall. We would recommend that you bring some seating.
