- * Conducted under the Rules of the Piping & Dancing Assn of NZ.
- Classes may be opened at the Committee's discretion.
- * Competitors may only win the most points cup in their own age group.
- Registration cards must be sighted to collect numbers.
- * Competitors enter at their own risk.
- * The Order of Events is indicative only and may be changed on the day.
- * Late entries will be accepted on the day at a cost of \$1 per dance.
- * A 4th medal will be given for 12 or more entries in any one class and a 5th medal will be given if 15 or more entries in any one class.
- * There will be the ability to set up gazebos and outdoor seating on a grassed area near the hall and there will be limited seating inside the hall. We would recommend that you bring some seating.

LOCAL PARENTS - PLEASE BRING A PLATE FOR MORNING OR AFTERNOON TEA

This competition is being held in school grounds and therefore a public area. The Club has no control over the photographing or recording of the participants in the competition and it is up to the dancer to ensure that they address any concerns they may have in this regard and take account of the public arena.
