- For the award of prizes (exception Boys, Learners, Restricted or sponsored events) the following entries must have been received 1st 3, 2nd 5, 3rd 7, 4th 15.
- 7 ALL COMPETITORS MUST BE REGISTERED WITH P&D ASSN NZ INC FOR THE CURRENT YEAR COMMENCING 1 JULY 2021 PIPING & DANCING MEMBERSHIP CARDS MUST BE PRESENTED WHEN COLLECTING NUMBERS.
