CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1 All fees must accompany entries to be accepted.
- 2 Competitors dance at their own risk.
- 3 Parents of competitors under the age of 17 and competitors from the age of 17 years must have been members of the Society for at least 3 months prior to the competition commencing and be financial at the time of entries closure.
- 4 To be eligible for trophies all associated events must have been competed in.
- 5 With the exception of Society Champion, Restricted and Learner Events - a solo dance will be substituted when a Reel has insufficient entr
- 6 For the award of prizes (exception Boys, Learners, Restricted or sponsored events) the following entries must have been received - 1st - 3, 2nd - 5, 3rd- 7, 4th- 15.
- 7 All competitors must be registered with P&D Assn NZ INC for the current year commencing 1 JULY 2024
Piping & Dancing membership card must be presented when collecting numbers.
- 8 Society Challenge Trophies - Trophies assessed by highest aggregate marks indicated by HAM
- 9 Refunds will be considered case by case on application up until the day of the competition with a medical certificate
- 10 All reels will be pre-drawn and dancers will compete in the order listed in the programme. Anyone wishing to withdraw from the reel event must let the competition secretary know prior to the start of the event.
- 11 **Points trophies are assessed according to By-Law 13, aggregate marks being applied in the event of a draw with the exception of the Joyce Armstrong Memorial Trophies when aggregate marks shall not be applied should a draw eventuate**
- 12 Any protest regarding Learners Classes must be lodged in writing prior to the competition commencing.
- 13 Competition will be run in accordance with all P&D rules or by-laws
