- Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the appropriate fees, to be paid online.
- Competitors dance at their own risk.
- All competitors must be registered for the current year. If unable to produce evidence of registration, competitors will be required to re-register.
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd prizes will be awarded in all events regardless of entries, with the exception of events relating to Rule 32 (Novice and Under 8 classes). Thereafter, 15 entries for 4th, 20 entries for 5th, 25 entries for 6th.
- In the event of a tie for cups or trophies, or Helen Balch Memorial Scholarship, aggregate marks will be used, and Rule 13 (P&D By-Laws) will be applied.
- In the event of insufficient entries being received for a Reel, a solo dance will be substituted.
- All Reels will be pre-drawn before the event. Entrants in these events must advise the Convenor if they intend to withdraw from the event.
- Should there be insufficient entries to hold any scheduled Championship, entries will be accepted on the day for that particular event, only for competitors registered in the competition. In the event of insufficient entries, prize money will be awarded as per a regular event.
- Competitors must compete in order of the programme, or at the discretion of the Board Steward.
- \$10 will be charged for a replacement number, If number is not returned at the conclusion of the competitions.
- All trophies and cups remain the property of the Christchurch Competitions Society Inc, and must be returned to the Trophy Secretary/Convenor on request. Trophies must be returned cleaned and engraved with the winners name, and year of receipt. Loss or damage to any trophy is the full responsibility of the recipient.

## Scholarships:

## Summer School Tuition Scholarships - \$100.00

6 Scholarships will be awarded across all ages at judges and convenors discretion. Scholarships will be paid directly to Summer School on confirmation of enrolment.

## Helen Balch Memorial Scholarship - \$100.00 Tuition Scholarship

The Helen Balch Memorial Scholarship will be awarded to the competitor who receives the highest marks over the three classes in their own age group (5,3,1). Competitors must compete in all three of the qualifying classes to qualify for this Scholarship. Qualifying Classes are identified by *HBM*. This scholarship will be paid to the dance teacher of the winner to be used towards their terms dance fees.
