- 1. All competitors to be suitably attired in Highland dress.
- 2. Competitors **MUST** report to Board Stewards prior to **EACH EVENT** otherwise their right to compete may be forfeited.
- 3. Competitors will play in order as listed in programme and should have their pipes tuned in readiness unless special circumstances occur. Any changes to be arranged with stewards prior to each event.
- 4. Pipers should have their pipes tuned in readiness when called on to compete and shall have for tuning at the competition platform such time only as the judge's discretion may allow, normally within the time limit of three (3) minutes for light music and five (5) minutes for Piobaireachd.
