Conditions of entry:

1. Conducted under the by-laws of the Piping & Dancing Association of NZ Inc.
2. Registration cards must be shown when uplifting competition number.
3. All competitors must be in National Dress when receiving awards (P&D by-law 19.2).
4. Medals presented for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in classes under 14 years (15 competitors = 4th placing).
5. For all classes 14 years and over 1st \$7.00, 2nd \$5.50 and 3rd \$4.00 unless otherwise stated.
6. Ribbons presented for VHC, HC and C at the discretion of the adjudicator.
7. Sashes and rosettes awarded for Marlborough Premier Awards instead of medals. Class 23 will also be awarded prize money as stated in rule 5.
8. Points gained in classes 1, 8 and 20-24 are not included in most points or runner up trophies.
9. In the event of a cup tie, aggregate marks will be used in accordance with P&D by-law 13.
10. All competitors compete at their own risk and Marlborough Highland Dancing Society Inc. accepts no responsibility for accidents or mishaps, and on these conditions only are entries accepted.
11. If you elect not to grant the Association/Society the right to use your image, it is your responsibility to remove yourself from situations where photos are likely to be taken, such as at presentation time. The Association does not guarantee that your image will not be published as part of a larger group or performance photograph, and by participating in the competition or event you automatically waive your rights in respect of such images.
12. **COVID-19 PROTECTION FRAMEWORK:** In accordance with the guidelines set out by PDANZ, all attendees (competitors, committee members, teachers, spectators etc.) over the age of 12 years and 3 months will be required to provide a valid vaccination certificate for scanning on entry to the venue. Any further updates due to COVID-19 Framework changes will be emailed to all entries if necessary.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> My Vaccine Pass must be sighted for all attendees 12 year and over. (NB: as per covid19.govt.nz - Children under the age of 12 years and 3 months are not required to show proof of vaccination status under the traffic light system). Medical Exemption: (as per covid19.govt.nz) If you are unable to get the COVID-19 vaccine for medical reasons, there is an exemption process to get your My Vaccine Pass. You will need to talk to your doctor and they will apply on your behalf. Contact Tracing system must be put in place by the organisation conducting the competition. (QR Code or manual sign in system for those who can't scan in.) Any person who is unwell should not attend the competition. Hygiene: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hand Sanitiser is to be available throughout the venue. (If outdoors competition, ensure Hand Sanitiser is available at the Secretary's Table and beside Dance / Piping / Drumming Platforms.) Ensure washroom facilities have liquid soap and disposable paper towels. Suitable rubbish receptacles must be provided. Ventilation: (at indoor venues) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All doors or windows that can be opened should be opened to ensure good ventilation where no air conditioning system available. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Maximum number of attendees will be 100 (this does not include workers) (NB. Workers include anyone required to operate the business or service, and therefore includes paid and unpaid.) 1 metre physical distancing to be applied. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure changing rooms have a maximum of one person per square metre. Face coverings are encouraged but not mandatory. Organisers will either pre draw events or have the board steward draw for all competitors. Swords to be placed and handled only by the board stewards on the day. Reel Dances – dancers must sanitise before and after performing. Kitchen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No food sales will be conducted. Food preparation for Judges and officials must be conducted with increased hygiene measures in place – gloves to be worn and tongs used etc. 	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Face Coverings are encouraged but not Mandatory. <p><i>There are no number limits at orange.</i></p>	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No additional Controls <p><i>There are no number limits at Green.</i></p>
