

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Conducted under the by-laws of the Piping and Dancing Association of NZ Inc.
2. Registration cards must be shown when uplifting competition number.
3. All competitors must be in National Dress when receiving awards (P&D by-law 19.2).
4. Entries must be made via the online entry form and payment made via internet banking prior to the entry closing date. **No late entries will be accepted.**
5. All classes including reels will be pre drawn and competitor order will be as per the programme or at the board steward's discretion. The programme will be emailed to competitors prior to the event date.
6. Medals presented for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in classes under 14 years (15 competitors = 4<sup>th</sup> placing).
7. For all classes 14 years and over 1<sup>st</sup> \$7.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$5.50 and 3<sup>rd</sup> \$4.00 unless otherwise stated. Prize money payments will be made via online banking within 5 working days.
8. Ribbons presented for VHC, HC and C at the discretion of the adjudicator.
9. Most points awards will be calculated in accordance with P&D by-law 13., Method A.
10. Classes 1, 8 and 20-24 are not included in most points or runner up awards.
11. In the event of a cup tie, aggregate marks will be used in accordance with P&D by-law 13.
12. Under 16 competitors dancing in open age group will qualify for Freeman Cup most points under 16 years; competitors 16 years and over will qualify for Englefield Cup most points open.
13. All competitors compete at their own risk and Marlborough Highland Dancing Society Inc. accepts no responsibility for accidents or mishaps, and on these conditions only are entries accepted.
14. If you elect not to grant the Association/Society the right to use your image, it is your responsibility to remove yourself from situations where photos are likely to be taken, such as at presentation time. The Association does not guarantee that your image will not be published as part of a larger group or performance photograph, and by participating in the competition or event you automatically waive your rights in respect of such images.
15. This event will be run under the COVID-19 protection framework protocols and restrictions of the New Zealand Government and the Piping and Dancing Association of NZ Inc. current at the time of the competition.
