# **Conditions of Entry**

- 1. It is a condition of entry that the 'performer' becomes a financial member with the first entry. These membership fees prepay admission charges to all sessions during the Festival. Choirs, Instrumental and Dancing groups are regarded as one performer for membership fees.
- 2. <u>Age Limit</u>: Performers must be within the age limit stated on the day of the opening of the festival. Performers must be prepared to show proof of age if called to do so.
  No individual performer can compete in a higher age except in duos, trios or in a team item.
- 3. <u>Performers</u>: The Competitions (except where otherwise stated) are open to amateurs only, as defined in condition No 5. No performer shall compete more than once in each class, except in group items, duets, duos and trios. Performers may appear twice only in a duet, duo or trio class, but once only with the same partner. No performer may appear more than twice in any group class.

  <u>Duos, trios and groups to be entered and paid for by one performer only.</u>
- **4. Novice:** A Novice means a performer who has not at any time gained a first place at any Competitions Festival. Novices are not eligible to enter championships.
- 5. Amateur: Amateur status will be defined at the discretion of the executive committee.
- 6. <u>Judging</u>: The decisions of the judges must be accepted as final and binding and no discussions will be entered into with regard to their decisions. If any performer, teacher or other interested person shall prior to or during the competition communicate with any judge, the performer or performers concerned or affected may be disqualified. Interviews arranged by the Group Convenor shall not disqualify, provided that no improper communication is made thereat.
- 7. Protests: Any Performer desiring to protest must do so in writing, setting out the grounds, and lodge the same with the Secretary together with \$5.00 as a guarantee of bona fides. Should the committee, after investigation, deem any protest to be frivolous or unfounded, the deposit may be forfeited in whole or in part. No protest will be entertained unless lodged as specified above, within one hour of the judges' award in the event to which the protest relates, or within such time as the committee considers reasonable under the circumstances. The decision of the committee shall be final. The committee shall have the right to enforce Rules and Conditions of the Society upon its own initiative without any protest. No protest can be entertained against any decision of a Judge.
- 8. <u>Committee Powers:</u> The committee shall have the sole right of determining the status of any performer and of interpreting and applying the Rules and Conditions of the Society, and of deciding any matter arising in or about or in connection with or out of these Competitions and its decision on all questions shall be final and conclusive. The Committee reserves the right to delegate its powers to any of its appointed officials. The Committee may at its discretion delete or amalgamate any class for which there are insufficient entries.
- 9. <u>Trophies</u>: All Trophies which are the property of the Marlborough Performing Arts Competitions Society (Inc) <u>Must Be Returned CLEAN and POLISHED By The Entry Closing Date</u> to ATT: MPACS, ASB Theatre Marlborough, 2 Hutcheson Street, Blenheim 7201. Cup holder's entries are <u>not accepted</u> unless cups are returned with entries. <u>This Rule Will Be Strictly Enforced</u>. Engraving of cups is the responsibility of the holder before returning. Trophy holders will be sent an account for any repairs to trophies returned damaged
- 10. Accompaniment (Music & Instrumental): Competitors are advised to arrange for their own accompanists as no official accompanist will be provided. If you are from out of town or you are having difficulty finding an accompanist, please contact the Music Convenor for advice. Payment for any accompanying is by private arrangement with the accompanist. Please be considerate and make your arrangements at least 6 weeks prior to the competitions this includes sending the music to your accompanist. Unaccompanied items will not be disadvantaged.

Please Note: Recorded music is permitted. One backing track per CD.

# **Conditions of Entry (cont'd)**

### 11. Vocal Instrumental:

- **a.** Copies of all pieces (excluding test pieces), clearly marked on top right hand corner with name and class number must be lodged backstage at the venue at least 30 minutes before the commencement of your class. No copies can be uplifted until the session is completed.
- **b.** Entries will not be accepted in own selection classes unless all titles of the "Own Selection Classes" are shown on the entry form.
- 12. Tests: Wherever a test piece is specified in an age group each performer must render the test item.
- **13.** Repetition: Any person who has gained a first prize in two preceding Marlborough Performing Arts Competitions Society Festival in a solo performance shall not be eligible to repeat that same item. No performers shall render an item that he/she has previously rendered during the current Festival except where stated.
- 14. <u>CD's</u>: Must be played on the official stereo and will be operated by the official operator only. All CD's must be lodged at the music collection point at least 30 minutes prior to commencement of your class. CDs must be clearly labeled with name and class and only one track per CD. CD's must be in Windows XP format. **Nothing other than CDs will be accepted**. (Back up music on electronic device, ONLY if CD fails)
- **15.** Order of Performance: All performers must report to the stage manager before the commencement of their class, and must perform whenever called upon. Any performer who fails to comply shall be liable to forfeit the right to compete.
- **16.** <u>Time Limits</u>: All events are limited to three minutes, with exception of choirs, instrumental groups and where otherwise stated. The judge is empowered to disqualify performers exceeding this limit.
- 17. <u>Highland and National Dancing</u>: Events will be conducted under the rules of the NZ Piping and Dancing Assn unless otherwise stated. Performers must be prepared to show their P&D registration card when called upon to do so. The Piping and Dancing Association of New Zealand's Bylaws will take precedence over any other conditions stated in this Syllabus.
- **18.** Adjudicator: The Adjudicator may refuse to award a prize to a performer should the number of marks gained be less than 50% of the possible marking.
- **19.** <u>Previous Relationship with Adjudicator may compete if he/she has taken lessons from the Adjudicator within six months prior to the competitions.</u>
- 20. Prompting: No prompting or assistance of any kind may be rendered during a performance except by the Judge.
- 21. Entry into these competitions constitutes your permission to publicly publish results.
- **22.** <u>Videoing:</u> Recording of performances is only allowed by permission of the committee. If you wish to record your child's performance/s, complete a request form (located on the back of the entry form) and return with your entry. A 'recording pass' will be issued and must be displayed at all times when recording performances.
- 23. Refunds If for any reason a competitor withdraws from a class or classes there will be no refund of fees.
- 24. <u>Restricted Classes Fancy Dancing</u> 'Restricted' status applies to a competitor who has not won first place in the section entered at this or any other competition (e.g. competitor can enter the Restricted Barefoot class if the competitor has never won first place in a Barefoot class at this or any other competition).
- 25. "By entering this competition or event, I agree to hereby grant M.P.A.C.S. and the Piping and Dancing Association of New Zealand (Association) the right to use my name, image, photograph, picture or video captured performance in connection with the Association. This includes granting the Association all rights to reproduce, edit, exhibit or otherwise exploit my name, image, photograph, picture or video captured performance, in whole or in part, in any media publication, Association website or materials, or other Association publication." YES/NO \*\*Please complete the question on the entry form\*\*
  - "If you elect not to grant the Association/Society the right to use your image, it is your responsibility to remove yourself from situations where photos are likely to be taken, such as at presentation time. The Association does not guarantee that your image will not be published as part of a larger group or performance photograph, and by participating in the competition or event you automatically waive your rights in respect of such images."




