ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- * Conducted under the Rules of the Piping & Dancing Assn of NZ and in accordance with any guidance issued by the Piping & Dancing Assn of NZ in respect of Covid-19 restrictions.
- * If there are not enough dancers for a championship event, the dance will be run as a special event and each dancer will be refunded \$1 and the prizes for events 1 and 2 will be medals and the prizes for events 3 and 4 will be 1st \$8, 2nd \$6 and 3rd \$4.
- * All classes will be predrawn.
- * The Committee may add or substitute Judges if numbers of entries or change of circumstances require.
- Competitors may win the most points cup in their own age group only.
- Registration cards must be sighted to collect numbers.
- Competitors enter at their own risk.
- * The Order of Events is indicative only and may be changed on the day.
- * Late entries will be accepted on the day at a cost of \$1 extra per dance.
- * A 4th medal will be given for 12 or more entries in any one class and a 5th medal will be given if 15 or more entries in any one class.
- * There will be the ability to set up gazebos and outdoor seating on a grassed area near the hall and there will be limited seating inside the hall. We would recommend that you bring some seating.

We will advise shortly after the closing date whether a kitchen will be operating for the purchase of food.

LOCAL PARENTS – PLEASE BRING A PLATE FOR MORNING OR AFTERNOON TEA

This competition is being held in school grounds and therefore a public area.
