Light refreshments will be available at the venue. Local competitors are requested to bring a plate.

CHANTER	Open to those who have NOT previously competed in a piping event. Competitors are to play ONE 2 parted tunes of any time signature, from memory. They will be expected to "beat time" and maintain even tempo.
NOVICE MARCH	Open to those who have not won a 1 <sup>st</sup> prize in ANY EVENT (Chanter event excepted). Competitors are to play a march of any time signature.
"D" GRADE	2/4 March – 4 parted tune; Strathspey & Reel – minimum 2 parts of each; Slow March – a 2 parted slow air or slow march with parts repeated.
"C" GRADE	2/4 March – minimum 4 parts; 6/8 march – minimum 4 parts; Strathspey & Reel – minimum 4 parts of each.
"B" GRADE	2/4 March; Strathspey & Reel; Hornpipe & Jig; 2/4 March and Strathspey & Reel will be played after each other, and judged as separate events – may be played through or a tune-up break taken. Pipers in B Grade must submit 2 tunes of each time signature on the entry form.

Pipers may compete one grade above their grading and in any Piobaireachd event. B Grade – 2 tunes to be submitted on the board. Events with less than 3 competitors may be declared non-events, at discretion of Otago Centre.

PRIZES:	B Grade: \$10, \$8, \$6. Other events: Medals 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th.	
CHALLENGE CUPS:	3 entries - 1 prize; 5 entries - 2 prizes; 7 entries - 3 prizes; 15 entries - 4 prizes. Most Points: "B" "C" "D" Grade - Held until next Junior Piping competition

TROPHY POINTS:	Under Rule 13 - aggregate marks will be used when points are tied.	
<b>REGISTRATION:</b>	ALL PIPERS MUST BE REGISTERED TO COMPETE (Except for Chanter Event)	
PIPERS DRESS:	By-laws will be strictly adhered to. Cloth numbers will be worn.
