GENERAL CONTROLS THAT APPLY AT ALL LEVELS FOR COMPETITIONS	ADDITIONAL CONTROLS SPECIFIC TO EACH LEVEL	LEVEL
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any person who is unwell should not attend the competition. <p>Hygiene:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Competition organisers should have a box of disposable masks available as required. Hand Sanitiser is to be available throughout the venue. (If outdoors competition, ensure Hand Sanitiser is available at the Secretary's Table and beside Dance / Piping / Drumming Platforms.) Ensure washroom facilities have liquid soap and disposable paper towels. Suitable rubbish receptacles must be provided. <p>Ventilation: (at indoor venues)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> All doors or windows that can be opened should be opened to ensure good ventilation where no air conditioning system available. 	<p>Outdoor Events: - No number limitations.</p> <p>Indoor Events: - Maximum number of attendees is up to 200 (this does not include workers) (NB. Workers include anyone required to operate the business or service, and therefore includes paid and unpaid.)</p> <p>Note: The size of the venue, combined with physical distancing requirements, may mean that less than 200 max. can be in attendance. The Host committee may also decide to further restrict the maximum in attendance, taking into account any other safety requirements.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Masks must be worn by all attendees aged 8 yrs (or Year 4) and over unless a valid mask exemption is supplied. (Masks only to be removed by competitors prior to performance on stage) Competition organisers should have a box of disposable masks available as required. Organisers will either pre draw events or have the board steward draw for all competitors. Swords to be placed and handled only by the board stewards on the day. 1m Physical Distancing Requirements to be applied in venue: This includes <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensuring a minimum of 1 metre distance between each family group in changing rooms. 1 metre spacing should be maintained between competitors lined up waiting to compete and between prize winners during presentations. Reports for Dancing Competitions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> With the exception of Island and New Championship classes, no judges' reports at the Red Traffic Light setting. For Island and NZ Championship events both the Judge and the writer must wear a mask. Kitchen: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> No food sales should be conducted. Food preparation for Judges and officials must be conducted with increased hygiene measures in place – gloves to be worn and tongs used etc. 	
	<p>Masks are encouraged but not Mandatory.</p> <p>There are no number limits for indoor or outdoor events at orange.</p>	
	<p>No additional Controls</p> <p>There are no number limits for indoor or outdoor events at Green.</p>
